## COMMUNITY AWARENESS BULLETIN

Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office is currently experiencing burglaries to vehicles and residences. Many residential burglaries are occurring between the hours of 7:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. and either alarms have not been utilized or windows and doors have been left unlocked. Vehicle burglaries have been occurring due to car doors being left unlocked, or property being left inside the vehicle in plain view. Vehicle burglaries normally occur between 9:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.

### Crime Prevention Tips

- Before leaving your residence, secure all windows and doors. Leave lights on at night.
- Activate alarm, (if you have one).
- Report any suspicious cars, (tag numbers and or, vehicle description) to the Sheriff's Office.
- Report any suspicious persons (physical and clothing description) to the Sheriff's Office.
- Look out for your neighbors house.
- Use lighting with motion sensors.
- Lock your car doors, and keep the windows rolled up.
- Do not leave purses, wallets, cell phones, laptop computers, money, cameras, CD's, credit cards etc. in plain view.
- If you have a garage, please use it.
- When you go shopping, park in a well lighted area.
- If you have a car alarm, please activate it.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
